

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

World Teachers Day







Today is World Teachers Day and what a well-deserved treat we received here today at Faulconbridge PS! First and foremost, thank you to our incredibly dedicated teachers who have gone above and beyond this year as they have navigated their way through the most challenging of years. Their hard work and commitment hasn't gone unrecognised and I thank them personally for their work. A big thank you goes to our P&C and families who surprised our staff this morning with what can only be described as in incredible feast! We were treated to brownies, cookies, cupcakes, sandwiches, home made sausage rolls and lets not forget amazing coffee! Thank you once again to our teachers and community.

Welcome back to face-to-face learning at FPS!!!

What a wonderful past two weeks we have had and there have been many things to celebrate. First, we welcomed back our Kindergarten and Year 1 students, followed by years 2 – 6 this week, and what a privilege this has been for me as Relieving Principal, to be a part of this. Whilst I know that there were mixed emotions from many of us in the lead up to the return of face-to-face learning, we have seen amazing resilience from the students who have quickly settled back into routines and enjoyed seeing their friends and teachers face-to-face.











I would also like to thank the community for your cooperation and understanding in this transition and thank those who have provided the school with feedback around this transition. I acknowledge that having multiple drop off and pick up points and times does add a layer of complexity to some of our families routines but ask that you continue to support us in this arrangement as we ensure that we are working within the NSW DoE education and NSW Health guidelines. Further to this, I would like to clarify some points that have been brought to my attention.

In light of the feedback received, I would like to clarify the following:

- Students who arrive / depart on the bus will enter and exit the school via the gates in the bus bay, regardless of their Cohort grouping, as the safety of the students is paramount.
- Lunch and recess eating time has remained the same with our new playground organisation, though there was some confusion in terms of students being able to continue eating once they moved to their designated play area. This has now been clarified. If students still have some of their food to eat / drink at the conclusion of eating time, they are able to take this with them to their allocated playground and bins will be relocated to enable students to dispose of any rubbish as needed.
- Entry / exit points: I know this has caused some challenges for families with multiple children and that routines have been changed. I appreciate the flexibility of our families in following the entry and exit points for cohort groupings and ask that where possible and safe to do so, these arrangements are followed. The safety of our students and community is our priority, so please make decisions relevant to your family circumstances, prioritising safety.

Opportunity Class Placement Test update

To comply with the latest advice from <u>NSW Health</u> to minimise the risk of COVID-19 transmissions, the annual Opportunity Class Placement Test will now take place at a student's own school rather than in examination centres which bring students from across settings and sectors together.

To allow this change to be made, the test date is now 17 November 2020.

The department acknowledges the challenges faced by students during the pandemic response. The safety of our students and staff is of paramount importance.

Marking of tests and student placements will continue to be managed by the High Performing Students Team.

Only students whose parents have received a confirmation email from the High Performing Students Team are eligible to sit the test on the new date of 18 November. The application portal will not be re-opened for new applications.

Placement in an opportunity class will be based solely on the results of the test to ensure the fair and consistent assessment of students across all schools and regions of NSW. Principals will not be required to provide school assessment scores, but are requested to verify the information entered by parents.




