Policy

- 1. That there be 8 Prefects in total, 2 of whom will be School Captains (1 male and 1 female).
- 2. That these Prefects (including Captains) follow a Code of Conduct (e.g. wearing school uniform, having exemplary behaviour, set good example i.e. school involvement).
- 3. That the Prefects represent our school at special school and community functions as appropriate.
- 4. That Prefects be assigned duties (viz. running school weekly assemblies and ringing of bells etc.).
- 5. If breeches of Code of Conduct occur Prefects and Captains may lose their rights to retain the role.

Procedure for Selection

- 1. Nomination by student and seconding by another student.
- 2. Scrutinization by staff and vetting of nomination forms where necessary.
- 3. Year 5 voting, to cull nominees to a manageable number.
- 4. Introduction of nominees to children (done by teacher at assembly so younger children in particular can identify nominees).
- 5. Nominees are to write their leadership speech at school and under the supervision of their classroom teacher. They will be expected to have a meeting with the Principal to discuss their application prior to this.
- 6. Students in Years 1 –5 vote for 8 students.
- 7. Voting by children.
 - Stage 1 vote for 8 students counted as x 1 value.
 - Stage 2 vote as above, counted as x 2 value.
 - Year 5 vote as above, counted as x 3 value.
 - Teachers vote as above, counted as x 4 value.
- 8. Announcement of Prefects. Information to teachers first, then nominees phoned at home. Prefects will then be introduced to the school community.
- 9. Prefects will be invested at Celebration of Student Achievement, (parents to pin on badges).

Nomination Form

Nomination form to have written on it: ... "this person being nominated has shown him/herself to be worthy of nomination by conducting him/herself in an appropriate way in all school situations, being a responsible "school citizen", showing a caring, helpful and supportive attitude towards other children, wearing school uniform ... etc.
